### Spalding Authorized Tutor (SAT)

A Spalding Authorized Tutor...

- ✓ implements *The Spalding Method* in a home, school, or other setting.

### Prerequisites

- Minimum of a high school diploma or GED
- Completion of WRTR 1 or MILA 1 with a grade of A

### Application Process

When prerequisites are completed...

- Send the application to 23335 N. 18<sup>th</sup> Drive, Suite 102, Phoenix, AZ 85027 Attn: Professional Development Specialist.

### Practicum (Observations)

Submit to SEI Director of Instruction, Certification, and Accreditation. . .

- A fifteen-minute initial DVD and fee. Use the SEI Demonstration 1 Directions to demonstrate Oral and Written Phonogram Reviews.
- After receiving written feedback on demonstration 1, prepare Demo 2 incorporating any suggested refinements; submit to the Professional Development Specialist.
- After receiving written feedback on demonstration 2, prepare Demo 3 incorporating suggested refinements from previous lesson; submit to Professional Development Specialist.

#### Practicum/Observation Fees

### Authorization Period

- Authorization shall be for three years.
